Friends,

I wanted to share our upcoming plans for worship gatherings throughout the fall. And I want to begin by thanking the members of the Re-Launch team, our staff, and lay leadership their continued leadership, guidance, and support.

August 2020

This Sunday, August 23rd, we will meet at 10:00 a.m. online only. Our next in-person outdoor gathering (weather permitting) will be on Sunday, August 30th, when we will once again meet under the oaks and conclude our summer study of Matthew 10. Our focus verse for the day will be Matthew 10:40-42.

September 2020

Sunday, **September 6th** (Labor Day Sunday) will be split between those heading to Camp Tekoa and those remaining, online. In September, we have two in-person gatherings planned.

September 13th will be a worship tailgate (more information to follow) and on **September 27th** we hope to be meeting in the building.

September 20th will be online only. **As we look to October and November**, we are looking at twice monthly in-person gatherings with the remaining Sundays online. We are planning special celebrations of World Communion Sunday and All Saints Sunday. We are also beginning to look towards Advent and Christmas although no decisions have yet been made.

Online options for Cross Cultural Ministries and small groups such as Sunday School and Bible Study will continue. Online worship will also continue every Sunday even when we meet in-person. As the state of North Carolina moves through phases, we may need to adjust. As always, we are taking into consideration best practices and guidance from health, church, and governmental leaders.
