YOUTH MISSION CAMP WAS A SUCCESS!

Last week in Pender and Braden counties, First UMC Hendersonville and St. Andrew's UMC joined forces to:

Built three new wheelchair ramps, removed three old ramps for replacement, made repairs on another ramp by replaced rotting boards, and added new railings. Then finished by pressure washing the ramps.

Built three decks with stairs (an 8 x 8 deck, a 6 x 6 deck, and a smaller landing), repaired several sets of stairs, replaced rotting wood, and stabilized railing.

Fixed and repaired floors in 6 different rooms, and did many little jobs to help out the homeowners. This included yard work, pressure washing, plumbing repairs, grab bars, house numbers, and more.

It was a great week that could not have happened without the support and prayers of the church. The youth and adults pay a portion of the cost of the trip, but the rest is paid through fundraising
