WORSHIP UPDATE

This Sunday, June 18th, we welcome Geoffrey and Deborah Hemenway in the leadership of the worship service. We appreciate their willingness to share "God's word" with everyone.



IN THE PAST YEAR, we have had churches in our conference that have closed or have chosen to disaffiliate from the United **Methodist Church.**

This can leave members of those churches without a church home. The conference has established Lighthouse Congregations, local churches in the NC Conference that are equipped and willing to be a caring and hospitable place that welcomes anyone whose church has closed or disaffiliated. Lighthouse Congregations are committed to: Worship (providing online or onsite worship opportunities that engage and welcome new people), **Discipleship** (create space to learn and grow), Mission (invite others into opportunities to serve through hands-on ministries),

Sacrament (offer communion at least 1 Sunday a month but also outside of traditional worship if needed), Pastoral Care (offering care to those in need - responsibility of the pastor and the congregation). Lighthouse Congregations also agree that they will not be seeking disaffiliation prior to the 2024 General Council meeting. As you can see, the commitments of a Lighthouse Congregation are things we are already doing here at

St. Andrew's UMC. At our most recent Church Council meeting. the council voted and approved for St. Andrew's to apply to be a Lighthouse Congregation. We will continue to welcome and invite all to participate in the work we do to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.


