A NOTE FROM THE FINANCE

COMMITTEE. Help our church end the year in a healthy financial position. *The goal is to raise an additional \$50,000 in second-mile*

giving between now and December 31, 2023. With 100



giving units this amounts to an extra \$125 per month or \$30 per week. We know that some will match this goal, some will exceed it, but we trust everyone will offer what they are able.

Between May and July, we saw the summer slump in giving. At the same time, there were increased facility expenses, such as the relocation of SAUMC's preschool to the Emerywood Hall (we'll be hosting an open house soon), maintenance, insurance, roof, HVAC and custodial services. While our building is aging, we celebrate that its use and ministry potential continues to grow. We will soon welcome the Alliance Center for Education, Learning Help Centers of Charlotte, Arts + Project Harmony, and Charlotte Mecklenburg Library's Learning Together who are resuming their school year ministries. That means over 250 children (and their families) will be present in our church 5 days a week. You are always welcome to stop by for a visit during the week to see and know that the Lord is good!

Your Finance Committee is striving to be good stewards with all we have been blessed. We have received some unexpected gifts that have helped this year. We continue to explore ways to best utilize our assets to further our community ministry and raise income to offset costs.

Thank you for doing your part so that St. Andrew's may continue to be a Lighthouse to the community as we Follow Jesus and Make Disciples for the Vital Transformation of Life (ours and the world).


