

CARD MAKING ACTIVITY: CHRISTMAS CARDS. Join us every Wednesday now through October 2nd at 10:00 a.m. or 7:00 p.m. to make cards in the Commons Room #1. It's a lot of fun and fellowship. Classes are in English and Spanish and will run for 10 weeks. HELPING HANDS

As of July 31st, we've provided \$3,400 in assistance to our neighbors and community, an average of about \$485 a month.

The help includes rent. lodging, utilities, gas cards, bus passes, and grocery store cards. Assistance is also given with referrals to Loaves and Fishes as well as other community agencies such as Crisis Assistance Ministry. The assistance provides not a hand out, but a hand up to carry folks a bit farther down the road. Hebrews 13:2 reminds us to always show kindness to strangers for in doing so we entertain angels.
