YOUTH MISSION CAMP

It is time to register for the 2015 Youth Summer Mission Camp! Here is the basic information for the trip:

Youth Mission Trip Information:

Where: Wilmington, NC – Staying at First Presbyterian Church downtown Wilmington.

What: Working with Wilmington Area Rebuilding Ministries to fix up some of our neighbors homes.

How much: \$150.00 for youth and no charge for adults (donations welcome).

When: June 21st-27th, 2015.

Who: Youth currently (2014-2015 school year) in 6th-12th grade can attend as participants, Safe Sanctuary trained and approved adults can attend as volunteer chaperones.

To register:

Step 1: Email Kevin at youth@standrewsumc.com

Step 2: Pay \$50.00 deposit by April 12th (2nd \$50.00 payment due May 10th, 3rd \$50.00 payment due June 7th)

Step 3: Make sure you have all forms turned in by May 31st (Health Form/Copy of Insurance card, SAUMC - Permission Form, WARM – Permission Form) – Forms are located outside Kevin's office

Note: If you back out of Mission Trip after June 1st, you will owe the full amount of the trip.

Folks need scholarship assistance need to ask for scholarships in writing please.

ADULTS NEEDED:

Since we run our own mission camp, we need lots of adults! Here are a few areas that we need adult help! (All adults must be safe sanctuary trained and approved – There will be training opportunities in April and/or May)

Kitchen Help – We fix two meals a day and need a kitchen crew to help. Our hope is to have 2 shifts (breakfast shift that also takes snacks/drinks to jobsites each day and a dinner shift that does the necessary grocery shopping as well).

Family Group Leaders – Family group leaders are on the jobsite with 7-9 kids each workday. These adults also help lead evening group devotion times and help keep up with their work team on our beach day (construction knowledge and experience are not necessary).

Construction Supervisor – These adults have a general construction knowledge and float from work site to work site helping get groups on the right track, helping trouble shoot problems, and helping deliver material.

Administrative Help – A few adults are needed pre-trip to help put together adult notebooks, make copies of paper work, and help with check-in and registration on the first day of the trip. These adults do not have to attend the trip, but are welcome to come and help with one of the previous three jobs!


