- To all persons entering and/or utilizing these facilities, please be advised that you are entering and using the (SAUMC) facilities at your own risk. Be it also known that any person entering these public spaces, do so knowingly of their own accord and therefore take the responsibility for their own health safety.
- Masking will become optional effective March 01, 2022. This will be a personal decision and (SAUMC) holds no responsibility for a person's decision to not wear a mask.
- (SAUMC) cannot completely eliminate the risk of someone coming in contact with COVID-19 or other infectious/communicable diseases but, to the best of our abilities, we are providing strong sanitation measures in accordance with CDC Guidelines, to provide a clean and safe facility within and outside of our church physical plant.
- (SAUMC) is also taking special additional safety precautions that are in place, to protect those that choose to enter our facility. These measures include providing liquid antiseptic liquids for hand sterilization and sanitary face masks to assist persons in the effort to minimize the establishment and/or spread of any virus such as COVID-19 or other infectious/communicable diseases they could encounter within the limits of (SAUMC), if desired. Sanitation measures and masks are available at the main entrances and gloves are available upon request.
- (SAUMC) also recommends the following CDC and the Mecklenburg County guidelines for minimizing the contamination and spread of the COVID-19 Virus:
  - Taking the COVID vaccination is recommended along with offered Boosters.
  - Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
  - Practice physical distancing (6'-0") when possible.
  - Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
  - Stay home when you are sick.
  - Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
  - Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
  - Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
