



WORSHIP UPDATE This week begins our Lenten

journey. During this season, we will be spending an extended time in the passion narratives found in the Gospels, and you are encouraged, as a Lenten discipline, to read through one gospel account each week. The stories are found as follows: Matthew 26-27, Mark 14-15: Luke 22-23 and John 18-19. On Sundays, we will also be using a resource from Amy Jill-Levine, a Jewish scholar and theologian. entitled "Witness at the Cross: A Beginner's Guide to Holy Friday." We'll spend the season of Lent with the witnesses to the crucifixion and spend time with them at the foot of the cross. As Levine shares, in the words of the old spiritual we are asked, "were you there when they crucified my Lord?" This begs the question of us, "what would you have thought, or done, had you been there? And as she offers in summary, "nobody said this was going to be easy. As always, getting to Easter means time at the cross and time at the tomb." I'm looking forward to the series, and spending time at the foot of the cross.
