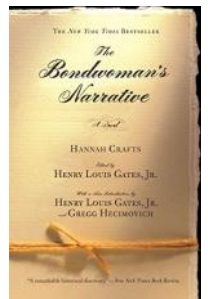
ASH WEDNESDAY Mark Your Calendar.
