OUR FINANCE COMMITTEE

recently shared the current financial status for St. Andrew's UMC as we began 2024 with a significant deficit. With that, the Finance Committee asked all committees to consider a reduction in spending of 20-25%. Staff Parrish has met over the last month to discuss the budget for staff and the need for reduction. We have taken an opportunity to review line items, take into consideration upcoming changes or impacts, as well as, consider budget norms from the district and within the Charlotte area. Although a difficult decision, we understand that it is a necessary one based on our status.

In order to meet the budgetary requirements, we proposed the following:

 Moratorium on any Continuing Education or Travel expense.

 Reduction of lay staff. Cross-Cultural Minister and Director of Worship salaries,

 Reduction of Senior Pastor salary,

 Elimination of Children's Minister position as of April 1, 2024.

Please know, that St. Andrew's is not in a unique situation as others within the district are making similar considerations. With Sherry Jackson's departure, admittedly, this is a loss I feel personally. I know as a congregation and family you all will be impacted as well, I want to take this opportunity to recognize her tenured service to St. Andrew's, its children, families, and community in being a light of Christ in all her work. She has spent her career fostering relationships, touching lives, quietly loving and supporting our church family. Her loss will be a notable one.

However, there is still good and important work to be done here at St. Andrew's. We are a church serving so many through God's work and as Pastor Sherri Barnes shared just a few weeks ago, have touched over 5,000 lives in 2023 alone.

On Palm Sunday. we will share in a Celebration of Service for Sherry Jackson. This will be

immediately following worship and in the Commons Room.


THE USE OF ZOOM ON SUNDAY MORNINGS FOR WORSHIP HAS
