CONFESSION

Merciful God, on the night Jesus knelt to wash Your disciples' feet, You showed us that true greatness is found in humility and love, yet we confess that we often seek recognition instead of service, comfort instead of sacrifice, and status instead of surrender. You call us to love "to the end," as You have loved us (John 13:1), and to wash one another's feet as You have done for us (John 13:14), but our love is hesitant and our service selective. Forgive us for the pride that keeps us from kneeling, for the fear that keeps us from saying, "Here I am, Lord," and for the times we fail to follow where You lead.
